Campers will be in their adventure group with at least two staff members, of whom, one or both are Wilderness First Aid Certified and Lifeguard Certified. Glisson provides group gear and supplies for each trip. If on an off-site trip, campers may be several hours from emergency services and may be subject to extreme weather. Some campers may participate in our low or high elements course lead by Glisson staff. All trips are subject to change at the discretion of the Glisson staff due to dangerous conditions, weather, or emergencies. Campers will be held responsible for their own behavior while participating in any of Glisson's Outpost programs.
