TRICKY WALK DOWN PART SIMPLIFIED:

A lot of beginner guitarists don’t know Bm (“B-minor”) or Bb (“B-flat”) yet. That shouldn’t stop them from playing this song. The work-around is a simple power chord, which is really a nice way to play the walk down anyway. Instead of a standard Bm bar chord, hold down E-string 7th fret, A-string 9th fret, and D-string 9th fret to form a B power chord (Chord tab = 7-9-9-x-x-x) Note: “x” means don’t play that string. Power chords work whether the standard chord is minor (Bm) or major (B). So, for the walk down, start with that B power chord (7-9-9-x-x-x) then walk down to a Bb power chord (6-8-8-x-x-x) to an A power chord (5-7-7-x-x-x).

Or, if you know Bm but don’t know Bb yet...just skip Bb. This song’s meant to be played by a mighty squadron of guitarists. Some will know Bb. Some won’t. And at some point, the ones who know can teach the ones who don’t. But if that hasn’t happened yet, crush those power chords like a boss or just leave out that pesky Bb.

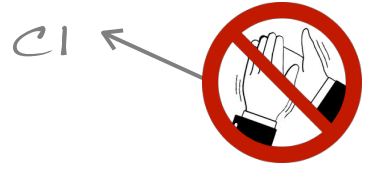

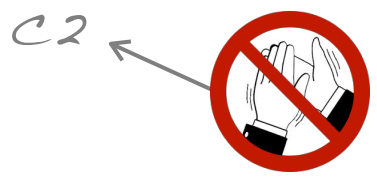
