Practicing What We Preach

If you want to become something, anything, you have to practice. You have to try and fail and try again – and it helps to have a coach guide you along the way. We know this is true with sports or music. It's the same with our faith.

Studies show we retain only 5% of what we hear, but 75% of what we do and 90% of what we teach. For 94 years, our passion has been providing immersive experiences of practicing Christian faith in ways that last because it translates to everyday life.

Most Christians make commitments of faith and answer God's calling as children and youth, and most of those commitments are made at camp: where campers start faith journeys and also practice living out those commitments so their faith becomes a permanent part of who they are.

The more we practice anything, the better we become at doing it. And in a world increasingly void of relationships and filled with distrust, talk is cheap. We are in desperate need of people practiced at living out the love of Christ.

Glisson, ELI, Grow, and Shoreline are ministries designed for different contexts but with a shared mission: to provide places for children, youth, and adults to practice Christian faith and servant leadership so the world might be transformed by their presence in it.

This year's Impact Report is our accounting for our practice.

May God continue to bless our Christian practice together in the 95th year of these ministries, even as God has blessed us since Glisson began in 1925.



More Camp For More People

Since 2010, our work has been guided by the following vision adopted by the North Georgia Conference:

"To advance the evangelism and discipleship efforts of the local church, the North Georgia Annual Conference commits to rekindling its Camping and Retreat Ministries. We intend to develop Christian camping experiences that are more accessible geographically, culturally, ethnically and physically. Using existing facilities, churches and other available sites, we will double the current number of campers from 2,500 to 5,000 in the next 10 years."

NGCRM Annual Fund: 2017 Donors

Annual Fund donors help keep the price of camp lower, fund camperships, enhance programming, renovate facilities, and expand programs to reach new populations. For 2019, our goal is to double Annual Fund giving to \$300,000 in order to sustain and further the impact our ministries have on children, youth, and adults.


