

100th Anniversary Event Details: FAQs & Packing List

Is there anything that will happen on Friday night? Can I participate?

• Each event will have an opportunity to hang out at camp on Friday for a night of worship in the chapel and a chance to sit by a fire to make a s'more or two, reconnect with old friends, and make some new ones too. All registered participants are able to attend this offering, but overnight lodging on-site will only be available for those who reserve it prior during the registration process.

What is the Cancellation Policy?

- Notice of cancellation must be received by Glisson staff in writing (email or postal mail) in order to be processed.
 - More than 4 weeks prior to the event: If notice of cancellation is received more than 4 weeks
 (28 days) prior to the start of the event session, a full refund will be automatically processed
 - Within 4 weeks of the event: If notice of cancellation is received within 4 weeks (28 days) of the event session, the \$40.00 registration fee is forfeited. *Any add-on purchases paid to reserve activities or lodging are fully refunded*

What is the Transfer Policy?

• There is no charge for transfers as long as they are requested more than 4 weeks prior to the event session. Transfers are subject to event availability. Within 4 weeks, transfers will come with a \$10 transfer fee. No transfers are able to be made within 2 weeks of the event.

Who has to register?

All attendees. So that we know everyone we have on site, everyone who attends the event has to
register – even your 0-6 year-old kiddos. Speaking of little tikes, participants under the age of 7 at the
start of the event will have a discount automatically applied to waive the \$40 registration fee. On a
related note, participants 6 and under will not receive a t-shirt, but shirts and other merch will be
available in the Camp Store during the event.

What are the on-site Lodging options for Friday night?

- Single Bed Reservation: \$30 fee
 - Reserves one bed in one of our village cabins the Friday night of the event weekend. Cabins will be broken by gender. Available to participants over the age of 19 by the start of the event.
 Reservation does not include any linens. Reservation grants access to Friday night activities and includes breakfast on Saturday morning. Limited availability.
- Full Cabin Reservation: \$300 fee
 - Reserves one Village cabin for use on Friday night of the event weekend. You are able to reserve it for your individual family or invite other families to join you, with a <u>total cabin</u> <u>maximum of 15 individuals</u>. Reservation includes exclusive use of the cabin for the event (15 twin size, bunk style beds and an attached bathroom with 3 sinks, 2 private toilet stalls, and 2

private shower stalls). Cabin rental does not include any linens. Reservation grants access to Friday night activities and includes breakfast on Saturday morning. Limited availability.

What activities are available during the event?

- Each event weekend will have 2 activity blocks on Saturday morning and afternoon where participants will be able to choose from a variety of activities; such as creek hike, crafts, hiking, storytelling, etc.
 These activities are all included in the cost of the event.
- For those wishing to add on additional options during these time blocks, those are available for reservation during online registration and may be available for registration on the day of the event, pending availability. These add-on activities will each carry minimum age requirements and will vary depending on the weekend chosen Options could include:
 - Zipline + Climbing Wall (available for ages 12+)
 - Lake Hale Waterfront (slides, zip line, jumping platform; available for ages 7+)
 - Kayaking at Lake Neal (available for ages 7+)
 - Pool (available for ages 7+)

Do I have to stay for the entire event?

 Attendance for the full day event is not required, however price will not be adjusted for shorter timeframes.

Are there differences between the events?

• The most obvious difference between the events will be the season in which each event happens. This will cause some variation between events (activities that are offered and potentially some locations of events), but by and large, event differences will be minimal. The November event will have a focus of remembrance of the saints that came before us over the past 100 years of belonging at Glisson.

Is my pet allowed to come?

• Sorry, no. Pets are **not** permitted at any of the 100th Anniversary Events.

What does the reg fee cover?

• The registration fee aims to cover the cost of the event. This will include lunch, a 100th anniversary t-shirt, and any supplies needed for activities and the event.

What to bring

- Daypack or book bag (for water bottle, rain jacket, etc)
- Waterproof rain jacket or poncho
- Sweatshirt or light jacket
- Comfortable walking/hiking shoes
- Sunscreen
- Bugspray (deet-free to protect program equipment)
- Water bottle

Optional items (note: some are required pending add-on activities)

- Old camp photos/Glisson memorabilia you'd like to show/share
- Musical instrument (for Singing on the Porch)
- Tennis Shoes (closed-toe shoes are required for participation in zipline+climbing tower)
- Water shoes with heel strap (for participation in creek hike, Lake Hale Waterfront activities, or kayaking)
- Swimsuit (for participation in water activities)
- Beach towel (for participation in water activities)
- Twin size bedding/sleeping bag and pillow (for those staying on-site Friday night)
- Toiletries and change of clothes (for those staying on-site Friday night)

What NOT to bring

- Tablets/computers
- Video games
- Tobacco/e-cigs/vapes
- Alcohol
- Drugs
- Fireworks
- Firearms/weapons
- Pets
- Water guns

- Any other valuable personal items
